

Dequan Zhang

PhD, Professor Dequan Zhang is graduated from the Chinese Academy of Agricultural Sciences, where he received the Top Ten Young Scientist Award. He also was distinguished Young Scientist Award by the journal of Scientific Chinese in 2012. He is the Director of Science and Technology Administration Department, Institute of Agro-Products Processing Science and Technology, CAAS; the leader of Meat Processing Innovation Team; Deputy Director of Comprehensive Key Laboratory of Agro-Products Processing, MOA; Director of the Meat Processing Research Group, National Modern Sheep Industry Technology System.

Prof. Zhang has been engaged in meat science and technology research for a long time, and his study mainly in three aspects: losses decreasing during post mortem; industrialization of traditional Chinese meat products and high-value use of bone and blood. Prof. Zhang chairs more than 20 projects, including the funding from National Program-Agro-Scientific Research in the Public Interest, National Modern Sheep Industry Technology System, National Natural Science Foundation of China and collaborations with companies. He has more than 100 academic publications as first author or corresponding author, applied 48 National Patents in which 18 has been authorized.

Prof. Zhang is the Vice President of Meat Products Committee, Chinese Association of Animal Products Processing; Executive Member of Agricultural Products Processing Chapter, Chinese Association of Agricultural Science Societies; Secretary-General of National Agro-Products Processing Technology Research and Development System.
